

DETENTION PAY INCREASE

FLEET-WIDE INCREASE

— Effective week-ending October 3rd – first check October 9th

Waiting on a customer is time you cannot spend generating payable activity or miles. It is one of the more frustrating parts of the job.

Nussbaum believes it is time to move the detention pay rate forward again.

\$20 → \$25 PER HOUR

+\$5
AN HOUR

A 25% INCREASE

+\$5 AN HOUR — A 25% INCREASE

Detention goes from \$20 to \$25 per hour. That is \$5 more on every detention hour you earn.

Detention authorization rules stay exactly the same. Only the rate moves.

AND YOU STILL GET THE “FIRST HOUR FREE” TREATMENT

Nussbaum will continue to pay detention starting after one hour from appointment time.

1st hour free is best-in-class for the trucking industry (nearly everyone else sits at 2 or more hours). And detention now pays 25% more.
